My family has owned the property at 724 Day Street for many years and before that worked at this property since 1961. We did sell it today but this will help the new owner, plus I am still renting at this property. Many years ago the city put up Loading Zone signs in front of 724 Day at the request of us because people working at what is now Georgia Pacific paper mill would park the road full every day and we couldn't park in front of our building. We talked to the city and they put up the Loading Zone signs and we could park there and we wouldn't get tickets. It was that way for over 30 years. Recently I got a ticket which I was able to get out of after explaining the situation. He suggested talking to an alderman since the mill workers no longer park here, so the signs serve no purpose. Can we get these signs taken down. We almost got tickets again last week.
