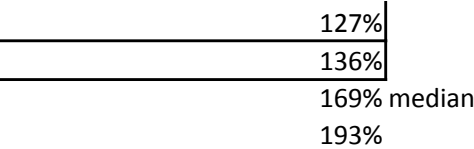

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE SPECIAL EVENT FEE SCHEDULE

January 14, 2020

BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN BAY:

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2019, the Common Council adopted General Ordinance Number 28-18, an Ordinance to Repeal and Recreate Section 6.15, Green Bay Municipal Code, Relating to Special Events; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.15(5)(c) of the Special Events Ordinance requires the Common Council to establish a Special Event Fee Schedule by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Special Event Fee Schedule is intended to reflect the actual costs incurred by the City in connection with special events;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council hereby establishes the following formulas for calculating special event fees:

- A. Non-resident Application Fees shall be calculated at a rate of one and one-half (1.5) times the City of Green Bay Resident Application Fee.
- B. Late Application Fees shall be calculated at a rate of one-half (0.5) times the City of Green Bay Resident Application Fee.
- C. Additional Fees for First-Time Events shall be calculated at a rate of one and three-fourths (1.75) times the City of Green Bay Resident Application Fee.
- D. Event Location Change Fees shall be calculated at a rate of one-fourth (0.25) times the City of Green Bay Resident Application Fee.
- E. Event Cancellation Fees shall be calculated at a rate of one-fourth (0.25) times the City of Green Bay Resident Application Fee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Common Council hereby establishes the following Special Event Fee Schedule in accordance with Section 6.15, Green Bay Municipal Code:

I. Simple Events, as defined in Section 6.15(1)(h).
