GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 05-20

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 21.11(8),
GREEN BAY MUNICIPAL CODE,
RELATING TO FINANCING OF LEAD
WATER SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT**

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN BAY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 21.11(8), Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read:

(8) Financing of Replacement. In the event funding is made available for this purpose through any means, an eligible property owner may apply to the City **and/or Water Utility** for financing of any portion of the cost of replacing a lead customer-side water service line under the terms of such financing program. Disputes regarding eligibility for financing may be appealed to the Water Utility Commission, unless otherwise noted in the funding program. As a condition of receiving any available financing from the City **and/or Water Utility**, the property owner must provide adequate documentation demonstrating that the contractor and/or plumber completing the work anticipated hereunder is properly certified and/or licensed by the State of Wisconsin and/or the City, as appropriate.

SECTION 2. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect on and after its passage and publication.
