- [Joanne] Sorry, staff recommendation is to approve. However, we are recommending that the approval be with a modification of removing the joining lot, or the outside joining lot from the premises description. It doesn't comply with our premises requirements, and also, in addition, we do have an ordinance in place that would allow the licensee to temporarily expand their license to include that lot. I'm going through that proper expansion of license premises application. So, we do have the application created and ready to go with the clerk's office, and that is all done at the staff level. So, the licensee would not need to come back to committee or council to get that approval. And that would allow the licensee to use that joining lot during this time, during this September, and it will automatically expire December 31st of 20.

- I was wondering, attorney Bungert, is there somebody here to do you know?

- [Joanne] I'm not sure if there is.

- Okay, I'm just saying, I'd like to hear what their said-state is. Police, can I ask your thoughts on this as well?

- [Steve] We concur with the law department, since that ordinance was created, if they fill out that one, we have no issue with that.

- Okay. Well, staff, we're on staff. Committee, what's your thought on this?

- I'm making a motion to approve with the changes that Joanne wanted.

- Okay, that's really lengthy. Joanne, you've got it all, right?

- [Joanne] Yes, so that would be a motion to approve with the license premises description of parking-lot, patio, bar, basement, coolers, outside.

- Sure.

- This is Burkel's One Block Over, it's over on that side-street, next to the old Bret Fire Steakhouse, next to the Springfield Suite, it's a restaurant and establishment right behind there, kinda tucked in behind Stadium view and the bar on Homegood Way.

- [Kathy] It says here, "Mean Street."

- No.

- The other one.

- Tony Canadeo Run.

- With that one, is that the one we just--

- Okay, we're not there yet. We'll get there.

- Oh, we weren't. I thought we were on, oh wait, which one was I on? Okay--

- We're on number four.

- We were, okay.

- Okay, we got time.

- [Kathy] I kind of know where Canidao is, so thank you.

- Okay, so all in favor, please say aye. All opposed, that passes unanimously. Now attorney Bungert if you wanna make sure that the owner gets this information and let us know if they comply. I would think they would, but if there's any issue we'd like to know.

- Yes, their license will essentially be issued with the description that was approved today at committee. So that is what they're going to be getting.

- Okay, thank you.

- Yep. All right, .

- Okay, number five, consideration with possible action on the 2020-2021 renewal application for a Class A liquor-- Pardon? What? For Tikapur Petroleum at 2115 Main Street with a change of agent. Staff. Hello? Staff, are you there?

- [Joanne] It's not, we are still currently in the 2019-2020 year, so licenses, liquor licenses are good until they expire June 30th, at midnight. And then the new license year begins on July 1st.

- All right,

- So, if they're having a change of agent, currently they need to make that change for the current year, and then, the next item, is for their renewal application with that new agent.

- Okay, well, thanks for the clarification, attorney. All right, do we have a motion?

- Motion to approve.

- Approve by Stevens, VanderLeest, a second, all in favor, please say aye.

- [All] Aye.

- All opposed, that passes unanimously.

- [Joanne] All right, item number seven.

- Number seven. Consideration with possible action on the 2020-2021 renewal application for a Class B combination license for TNT Holdings LLC, at 2511 West Mason Street. Nothing would their agent at the June 29th town and council meeting. Staff.

- [Joanne] Actually, I think that might be the wrong one, I think you were reading item number nine.

- License eight.

- No I wasn't. I was reading eight, according to this.

- [Kathy] Okay, according to city clerk states--

- [Joanne] All right, the agenda it is out of order. So, yeah, number eight, is that. Okay, all right, I will All right, we'll do--

- Did I read it right?

- [Joanne] Yeah, you read the correct one, except, on the, I don't know why, on the agenda it's switched. So that item that you read is labeled eight but it's nine in the system so--

- Yes.

- [Joanne] Okay, so, we're good. We can go ahead with motions.

- With the motion, okay, staff?

- Staff has no objections.

- Police?

- Police has no objections.

- Okay, then, entertain a motion?

- Motion to approve.

- I make a motion to approve.

- I'm gonna give this one to Alder Lefebvre, second by Stevens, all in favor, please say aye.

- [All] Aye.

- , that passes unanimously. Now we skip up to the other one, right?

- [Joanne] Yeah.

- Are you ready?

- Yes, sir.

- Okay, number nine. Consideration with possible action on a 2020-2021 renewal application for a class B-A beer license for a Isaias Alvarez, at 2030 East Mason Street, Suite B, for the change of license description to, quote, sold out of beer, overstocked the store to the walk-in cooler and backroom, quote. Staff.

- Motion to approve by VanderLeest, do we have a second?

- All in favor, please say--

- I keep waiting for Kathy.

- You were very good at that.

- What?

- He was very good on that. All right, we have a second. All in favor, please say aye.

- [All] Aye.

- All opposed, that passes unanimously.

- [Kathy] I just have one thing here I was looking at, and Suite B, that sounds kind of weird to me, like, is it in a strip-mall? It seems weird.

- [Steve] Yeah. This is Lieutenant Mahoney, yes, that's in a strip-mall. Once again, over on East Mason and Main Street. Kind of, tucked in. Right in that strip-mall there. I do know there's, like, a computer store in a stand-alone building that's the mall, right, the strip-mall right behind there.

- Oh, that one back there, okay, it just sounds weird when it's Suite B, sometimes you think, well then you'd have to walk into a hallway to get to it, usually that's the way it is but okay. All right, thank you.

- That's a good question. Okay, are we ready?

- [Joanne] Item number 10.

- Number 10, consideration with possible action on a request by Alder Skannel to appeal to the state to move the election from the first Tuesday of the month to the first Saturday. Referred from the Anaheim Committee on elections. I don't know, is Alder Skannel here? Okay. I would entertain other Alders and committee to chime in on this.

- [John] I'd like to chime in Alder

- Yes, go ahead, Alder VanderLeest.

- [John] I'd like to make a motion to receive and place this on file. Due to that there's over-time involved when it's on a Saturday, and it's not the best day. I know, he's trying to refer this, you know, from the Anaheim Committee from the elections, but I'm not in favor of moving it to a Saturday 'cause a lot of people that aren't available on Saturday won't be able to get out and vote. I'm comfortable with the Tuesday and I don't wanna really see the change because of the financial aspect of it. And, I think that, you know, his request is not a bad request but I just don't think it will work out so well so I'm not in favor of it. Thank you.

- All right. Well, I'd like to hear from some of the other Alders too.

- Alder Lefebvre.

- Oh, Alder Lefebvre.

- [Kathy] Let Alder Dorff go ahead.

- Oh, Alder Dorff?

- Sure, the reason that we referred this is because that we felt this wasn't the purpose for the elections, the adhoc elections committee, the adhoc for the November election and the August election of this year during the COVID-19 emergency. So, we felt it was better to come in here, and really, it's gonna need to be a whole

council action, so, you know, whatever you guys decide here, if Alder Skannel wants council to talk about it, he can bring it forward. And I did text him, I texted him a little while ago to remind him about his item, but he didn't probably see that yet.

- Okay. Well, I appreciate those comments, and I think you're right. The council will have to weigh in on that, everybody. Alder Gerlach, did you-- Alder Lefebvre go ahead.

- [Kathy] Yeah, I'm trying to remember what Randy had brought up. I believe it was something that Tuesday was some conflict?

- I'm not aware of that.

- [Kathy] It was something like that, I believe.

- Well that could come out at council.

- [Kathy] Yes, we can discuss it, but I just wanted to bring that up

- Yeah, okay. Well, that'll be another point. Alder Gerlach.

- I just wondered if Alder Dorff has any wisdom from the committee to share on this.

- No we did not talk about it, we immediately referred it, because that wasn't the function of our committee. So, there is no wisdom.

- There is wisdom, they just didn't want to share it, you know.

- Just not on this thing here.

- Well, you know what, there is a motion, do we have a second?

- Second.

- Second by Alder Stevens. They will receive and place on file. Regardless, it's going to be pulled, so, you know, all in favor of Alder VanderLeest's say aye.

- Aye.

- All opposed, okay, it will be pulled at council but if that passes the receive and place on file. Let me know when you're ready.

- [Joanne] Yes, one second. All right, item number 11.

- All right, number 11, consideration with possible action on a request by Alder Kathy Lefebvre to have staff gather and report all businesses in Green Bay that have Class A, Class B Beer, Class B Liquor, and Class B combination licenses. This should include type of business, whether it's a restaurant, bar, grocery store, gas station, or liquor store, name of business and address. A map of the locations would be helpful. Report back in July to give time to compile the report. So, it sounds like you wanted possible action, but it sounds like you want to also have time to compile the reports.

- [Kathy] Right, I knew it was not appropriate to put it in when I did, and have staff right away report 'cause this is really going to encompass a lot. I hope by, you know, at one of our July meetings, that they can come back with us. The reason I did it is because University, I've done stuff before, two miles on University. It is saturated with alcohol. I'm sorry, beer and alcohol. It's just, we need to know where these businesses are and we have to put some kind of limits because I think it's just too much, you know, in one area. We just approved the new which I think with this virus, I don't know how far they went ahead with it. And at that on University, in that same location, we have to be careful. We have to be-- Where these businesses are and we have to kind of control it a little bit. That's my feeling. And that's why I brought it up just so we are aware, we know where these places are.

- There is, I will say, Alder Lefebvre, and everybody else, 'cause I do like maps, I got a map a long time ago from the IT department that had a list of all of the bars and establishments that you're asking for. So, I think it's

out there, already. It would be nice to show it in person, it's a little tough on the computer, but it's like about three-and-a-half feet wide by two-and-a-half feet. It basically shows where the concentration is and of course, far side of West Mason, you've got, East Mason, you've got University, you've got the downtown area, you've got , you've got certain hotspots where there's a lot of it there. And, it is what it is. So, I will work with you on that, as well but I would say let back in July, so I would entertain a motion to receive a place on file.

- [Kathy] I make a motion to receive a place on file.

- Do we have a second?

- Second.

- Second by John VanderLeest, so all in favor, please say aye.

- [All] Aye.

- All opposed, that passes unanimously. We're getting there, we're getting to the bottom.

- [Joanne] All right, and we are on the violation report.

- Okay, number one, the liquor violation report for June 8th, 2020.

- [Steve] We have no violations to report for during this time.

- Wow, what a perfect world. All right, I'd like a motion to receive and place on file.

- A motion to receive and place on file.

- By VanderLeest, do we have a second, by Stevens, all in favor, please say aye.

- [All] Aye.

- All opposed, that passes . Before we adjourn, I just want to make sure we have a meeting time set for the next meeting.
