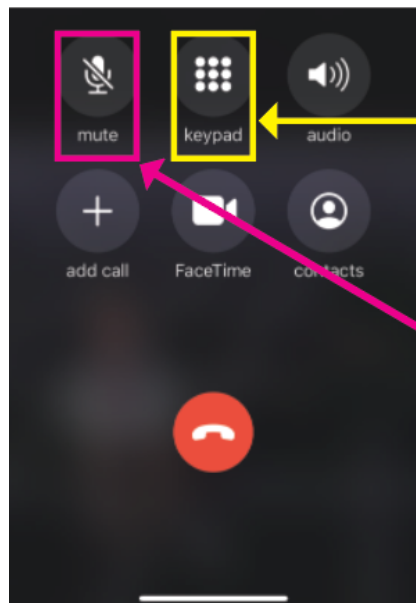

4. Waiting room

5. Using Zoom with a tablet or computer

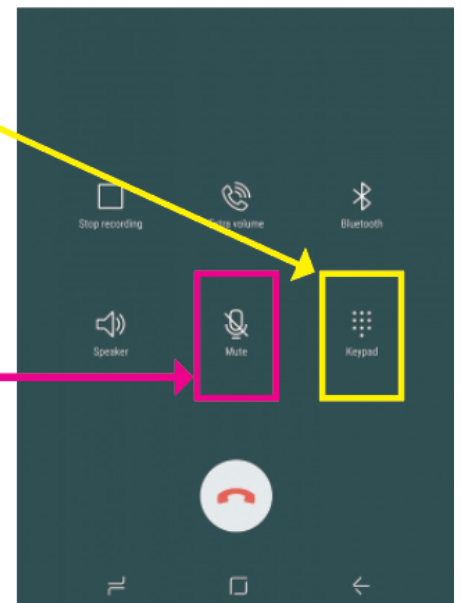

Liquor License Renewal Application
Recommendation of NON-RENEWAL**

The Green Bay Police Department does not support the renewal of Duel Sports' (Duel) liquor license. Mr. Cain, identified as the lease holder, and Mr. Rosio, the liquor license holder, have not made a full faith effort to reduce the number of disturbances at Duel, resulting in a sustained high number of police calls, including crime that could have arguably been prevented by Duel. The following is the liquor license information provided in the Application, and the law enforcement call history for this liquor license period. Referenced documents are attached.

Liquor license Renewal Application:

Holder/Agent: Russ H Rosio, 1403 Gross Ave., Green Bay

(Not listed on Application) Manager/Owner/Lease Holder: Mike L Cain, (see attached action for eviction and unpaid judgment for Duel and Mr. Cain)

*Application includes an affirmative (yes) response for No. 12, (Owing municipal property taxes, assessments, or other fees).

Data and Information Regarding Law Enforcement Calls: (Chronological Order-Most Recent First)

May 14, 2022:

- 20-year-old female gained entry to the bar with a fake ID. It was reported that Duel security recognized the fake ID and allowed her into the bar regardless.
- Later in the evening that same Security staff took the underage female's friend to his vehicle in the parking lot and sexually assaulted her by digital penetration.
- It was reported that Security staff offered the victim Cocaine "so she wouldn't feel anything" but the victim refused.
- Security staff person who is listed as the suspect, has been identified and is currently on parole for felony arson and burglary offenses. Suspect is currently on 13 years of extended supervision according to court records. As part of the suspect's identified parole conditions, the Suspect:

- Is not to have in his possession alcohol or controlled substances.
- Random testing at defendant's expense authorized.
- No entry into an establishment where the primary business is the sale of alcohol.
- No contact with persons convicted of felony drug charges.
- Suspect has been charged with 2nd degree sexual assault by use of force (Felony) and a probation hold.
- Another witness reported to GBPD detective that she told Cain that his bouncer sexually assaulted someone. She believes Cain downplayed it as he didn't want the police at his bar.
- GBPD has identified that the Suspect's criminal history and status is publicly available through Wisconsin Circuit Court Access, and a quick online check by Duel and Mr. Cain prior to hiring this male for his security staff would have informed Mr. Cain that this individual should not have been hired.
- Mr. Cain, as the owner, along with the liquor license holder, Mr. Rosio, were cited for allowing underage person on premises.

Cumulative Call Information, as presented May 17, 2022:

- To date (liquor license year 7/1/2021 to present)-111 calls for service to Duel that directly to the bar or parking lot
 - Disturbance calls: 47/Leads the city for disturbances
 - Weapons calls: 2, male pistol whipped in parking lot, shot fired in parking lot
 - Other calls included thefts, various crime prevention calls by patrol, and various drug arrests in the parking lot.
- In February 2022, Community Police, State Alcohol Tobacco, and Lt Allen completed a compliance check and found two Bartenders on scene without valid bartender licenses. Mike Cain arrived on scene and also did not have a bartender license. Duel was shut down for an hour before Mr. Cain could find a bartender with a valid license. Mr. Cain was asked if he kept a file of all his bartenders and a copy of their bartender licenses-Mr. Cain responded that he did not.
