Initial Request: Consideration with possible action on the request by Ald. Scannell on behalf of Faith Nolde to establish a NO PARKING HERE TO CORNER zone on the south side of Hubbard Street at Allard Avenue. (Ald. Scannell – District 7)

BACKGROUND

Per information from Ald. Scannell, the requestor has a disability and has difficulty unloading groceries to her house because a neighbor's truck is parked in front of her house most days in the existing 2-HOUR 7 AM TO 4 PM SCHOOL DAYS parking zone. Because a NO PARKING zone is by default a loading zone, the requestor would be able to unload groceries to her carriage walk and through her front door. A 55 ft zone would cover her entire frontage along Hubbard St.
