[Deanna] Okay, it's four o'clock, you can start.

- [Heidi] Okay, so... We will do a roll call. Do we have everybody?
- [Deanna] Yes, we have Pete.
- [Heidi] Just keep track of it.
- [Deanna] Yes, we have Pete, Alex, Craig, Attorney McQueen and you.
- [Heidi] Okay, and then I need an approval of the agenda from the September 21st meeting.
- I'll make a motion to accept.
- [Heidi] Is there a second?

- [Heidi] Okay, the first appeal that we have on our agenda tonight is Jared Krentz, requesting to move to 804 North Locust Street. Jared, you're present?
- [Jared] Yes, ma'am.
- [Heidi] Okay, so Jared, it looks like we just saw you in July and we approved you to reside at, hold on, I'm gonna pull up the address again, I'm sorry. 2065 White Oak Terrace, is that correct?
- [Jared] Yes, ma'am.
- [Heidi] Okay, and why are you requesting to move again?
- [Jared] So my parents bought a house and that's who I live with, and that's who I have to live with while I'm on house arrest and I'm also having some medical issues going out with my knee that my mom's been helping me with. And so as my stepdad and they, the place they live in now, the landlords sold without telling them, you know, there's new owners and the new owners want this. They wanna do, live in one side and rent or whatever the other side. And they chose to take this side, so they gave them a short notice to have to move and so then they found a house and they got approved for it. And we could be...
- [Heidi] Oh, I'm sorry, go ahead.
- [Jared] They could be moving anytime from this weekend, I don't know.
- [Heidi] Did they actually purchase the house or they're renting the house?
- [Jared] They actually, they technically close on the house on the 21st but they're most likely gonna be able to move in earlier because of the situation they're in.
- [Heidi] Okay, all right. Okay. Does the board... Hold on, Jared. Does the board want to have Jared go through what he was convicted of and all of that information?
- I don't think that's necessary since we discussed his case back in July. The only question I'd ask is, has there been any arrests or criminal activity from the petitioner?

- [Heidi] He's currently on the electronic monitoring program through the Brown County Jail?
- I agree with that.
- I agree, I agree with Alex. I don't need to rehash that, I remember it from July.
- I agree also.
- [Heidi] All right.
- I agree.
- [Heidi] Okay, perfect. Alex, do you want him to answer that question about whether he's been arrested?
- Yeah, Jared, have you had any run-ins with the law since July 20th?
- [Jared] No, sir.
- And under if the officer we have on the call here can verify that at least within the Green Bay system.
- Yeah, I see nothing in Brown County as far as written report, prior to that or after that.
- Okay, thank you.
- [Heidi] Okay, and then, Jared, you have the opportunity to talk about treatment in public or private session. What would you prefer?
- [Jared] I'll do public.
- [Heidi] Okay, so it appears as though, you've just got enrolled in treatments, is that correct?
- [Jared] Yes, I actually had my first meeting with them yesterday and it was, we were just waiting for everything to go through which my probation officer was constantly asking about it. And I finally, I got approved on Monday and I got to start yesterday.
- [Heidi] Okay, and then how often do they have you gonna attend?
- [Jared] Every Tuesday at 4:00 PM.
- [Heidi] And how long are the sessions?
- [Jared] They are about two hours long.
- [Heidi] Okay. All right.
- [Jared] And then, I'm also waiting for family services to get back to me so I can start my counseling.
- [Heidi] And that's more personal?
- [Jared] It's personal and all that, yes, and to get me through what I'm going through.
- [Heidi] And when you say that, is it because of your charges?

- [Jared] Yes, 'cause I do have different permit and I wanna feel, like, better myself to keep moving on with life.
- [Heidi] Okay. Does anyone have any questions for Jared?
- I do not.
- Yes, I've got one. I was wondering how did your first session go so far?
- [Jared] Actually, it went good, I participated quite a bit, I learned some things from the other participants and I caught on pretty quick, I already started on my first assignment and hopefully I'll be finishing that by tonight.
- Can I ask what the assignment is?
- [Jared] It's a biography, like, I gotta explain my charges, I gotta explain my background and everything, so, like, participants can know me better and so probably can help me better.
- Okay, thank you.
- [Heidi] Any other questions? No? I guess, I mean, we just saw him in July and we approved him to stay at the White Oak Terrace, I don't really have an issue with this other location that he is looking at moving at, especially since he'll be living with his mom and dad. Does anyone else have anything they'd like to discuss?
- I agree with you.
- Yeah, I'm in agreement with you, we already approved that, I don't see an issue with this.
- [Heidi] Okay. Is there anybody who would like to make a motion?
- Move to approve address specific.
- I'll second.
- [Heidi] All right, all in favor, aye!
- Aye!
- [Panelists] Aye!
- [Heidi] Okay. Jared, it looks like you are approved to reside with your parents at the 804 North Locust Street address. Again, if you decide to move from that location, you'll need to come back before us.
- [Jared] All right, thank you guys.
- [Heidi] Would you like us to have that mailed to the Locust or the White Oak address?
- [Jared] Actually, can I have you do the mail to the house 'cause my ex has been bringing me stuff and I don't know how long I'm gonna be here or when we're gonna be there and I don't want it to get mixed up with.
- [Heidi] I-
- [Jared] 'Cause that she'll run it to me and everything.
- [Deanna] I can email it to you if that works.

- [Jared] Yeah, that will work.
- [Deanna] Okay.
- [Heidi] Okay, perfect, all right, thank you!
- [Jared] All right, thank you guys.
- [Heidi] Jared, so I think that is the smallest and quickest meeting that maybe we've ever had in the history of our sex offender residency board. But does anyone have anything that they need to or want to talk about? No?
- Nothing here.
- Attend in person in October.
- [Deanna] Yes, hopefully soon. I did check with IT, they're hoping to have the parts in yet this month, it's a shipping issue and if they can get them yet this month, they're expecting to get the conference rooms ready for October.
- Yeah, somebody could just give a room number or something if they wanna attend in person.
- [Deanna] Yes, we would let you know the room number. It'll likely be on the third floor 'cause that's one of the larger conference rooms that we could record in.
- Perfect, thank you.

- [Heidi] Are we all looking at attending back in person or is just people prefer to do the Zoom yet?
