MEMORANDUM

Re: Police Lieutenant Rehire Policy

Date: August 31, 2023

The Police Department and Human Resources Department are recommending a rehire policy for Police Department Lieutenants, similar to the Patrol Officer rehire policy. The recommended policy is outlined below:

Eligibility:

- The former full-time Police Lieutenant has a minimum of 3-consecutive years of service with the GBPD.
- The former Lieutenant resigned in good standing as documented by GBPD management.
- The former Lieutenant is rehired within 1 year of the date of separation from City employment.
- The Lieutenant requesting to be rehired will be subject to the selection process as deemed appropriate by the Police and Fire Commission.
- If more than 1 year has elapsed between the former Lieutenant's separation and rehire date, the former Lieutenant will be considered a new employee and will not be eligible for the rehire benefits detailed below.

Service Credit:

- The Lieutenant will be reinstated with the same pay held immediately prior to separation of employment.
- The Lieutenant's prior period of regular City employment will be added to the current period, minus the break in service. The break in service will not be counted as part of the total service credit. The Lieutenant's service date and bargaining unit seniority (if different) will be adjusted accordingly.
- Service credit will be used for:
 - Vacation accrual rate and vacation picks (Article 14)
 - Shift assignments (Article 7)
 - Overtime (Article 8)

Service Credit Exclusions:

- Probationary period
- Sick leave
- Benefit plan waiting periods (i.e. health, dental, etc.)
- Wisconsin Retirement System eligibility based solely on WRS plan provisions
