GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 05-24

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 2-180, AND AMENDING  
SECTION 2-179 AND 2-327 OF THE GREEN BAY MUNICIPAL CODE,  
RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN BAY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2-180, Green Bay Municipal Code, relating to Economic Development Authority is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**SECTION 2.** Section 2-179, Green Bay Municipal Code, relating to Annexation Commission is hereby amended to read:

- (a) *Appointment and organization.* The Annexation Commission shall consist of six members, one of whom shall be a member of the Common Council and one who shall be a citizen member. The Public Works Director, the principal planner, the President of the City ~~Economic Development Authority~~ **Plan Commission**, and the Mayor shall be members by virtue of their offices. The Alderperson and the citizen member shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the Council. The term of the Alderperson shall be for one year, and the term of the citizen member shall be for three years. The Vice-President of the City ~~Economic Development Authority~~ **Plan Commission** shall be an alternate member for the President of the City ~~Economic Development Authority~~ **Plan Commission** and shall act with full powers when the President is absent or cannot act because of a conflict of interest.

**SECTION 3.** Section 2-327, Green Bay Municipal Code, relating to Disclosure of interests is hereby amended to read:

(b)(6) *Authorities.*

a. ~~—— Economic Development Authority.~~

**b a.** Housing Authority, including Green Bay Housing Authority Properties I, Inc.

~~c b.~~ Redevelopment Authority.

~~d c.~~ Transit Authority.

**SECTION 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5.** Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect on and after its passage and publication.

AN ORDINANCE  
AMENDING SECTION 10-89,  
GREEN BAY MUNICIPAL CODE,  
RELATING TO CIGARETTE LICENSE

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN BAY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** Section 10-89, Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read:

Sec. 10-89. Cigarette, **electronic vaping devices, and tobacco products retailer** license.

The sale and licensing of cigarettes, **electronic vaping devices, and tobacco products** in the City shall be regulated pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 134.65. Such section, exclusive of the penalties contained therein, is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this section as though fully set out at length.

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect on March 6, 2024, after its passage and publication.

## **Summary of Licenses Granted and Issued for Class “B” Beer & “Class B” Liquor Licenses:**

The City of Green Bay has a quota of 172 available “Class B” Liquor and Class “B” Beer licenses under state law.

The City granted 3 licenses that have not yet been issued (see page 1).

The City of Green Bay may only take the number of applications to the number of licenses available. Applications are considered to those who apply with a fully completed application and first in time.

## **Summary of Licenses Granted and Issued for Reserve Liquor Licenses:**

The City of Green Bay has a quota of 32 Class B Combination Liquor and Beer Reserve licenses under state law.

The City of Green Bay has 4 Class B Combination Liquor and Beer Reserve issued.

The City of Green Bay has 1 granted “Class B” Liquor and Class “B” Beer license-Reserve that has not yet been issued.

A Reserve liquor license in the City of Green Bay costs \$10,000 (one-time non-refundable issuance fee) plus the license fee prorated. The license shall not be transferred or surrendered.
