Officer Meves,

Thank you for allowing me to submit this statement. Your letter was read in haste, and it was not understood that positive replies were requested as well.

I live next door to the property in question. In the time that I have lived there I have had zero issues with these neighbors, including their dogs. While they do frequently bark, this has not been a nuisance to us. I have approached all three many times, and other than barking they have never appeared aggressive or threatening in any way. I have never witnessed any of them getting out of their yard, and have no issues with my young children playing nearby. I have also never needed to ask them to control or quiet their dogs while utilizing my own yard.

I have talked with Stacy and she tells me she is acquiring vibrating no-bark collars for the dogs, and fixing any inadequate fencing. She also stated that she has found someone to help with training the dogs to avoid any future issues. In my opinion they are responsible dog owners and are willing to make the changes needed to comply with the City and satisfy any neighbors who expressed concern. My wife and I are in favor of them being granted permission to keep a third dog, or at least granted an extension for these changes to be made and take effect before a final decision is made.

I have been with the Fire Department for 18 years, 15 of which as a paramedic, and have seen more than my fair share of aggressive and dangerous dogs (as well as their bites). I live and work in this district, and I take this issue very seriously. I do not know the circumstances of the previously reported bite, however if I had any concern for the safety of my family or my neighbors, as a public safety employee for this city, I assure you I would not be writing this letter.

- (3) *Immediately adjacent.* A licensed patio must be immediately adjacent to the indoor portion of the licensed premises. For purposes of this section, a patio is immediately adjacent if it can be accessed from the indoor portion of the licensed premises without crossing any unlicensed area.
- (4) *Barrier.* A licensed patio must be enclosed by a permanent fence, structure, or other barrier that clearly delineates the separation from licensed to unlicensed area. The fence, structure, or other barrier must be at least three feet in height and must clearly separate the licensed premises from any non-licensed area. Photographs of the barrier shall be provided with the application.
- (5) *Ingress.* Access to a licensed patio shall be through an indoor licensed area. Ingress to a licensed patio from an unlicensed area should be limited to safety purposes only. Egress to an unlicensed area without the ability to return shall not be limited, to permit egress for safety purposes.

I have reviewed the municipal code regarding the requirements of a licensed patio and my area complies with the ordinance.



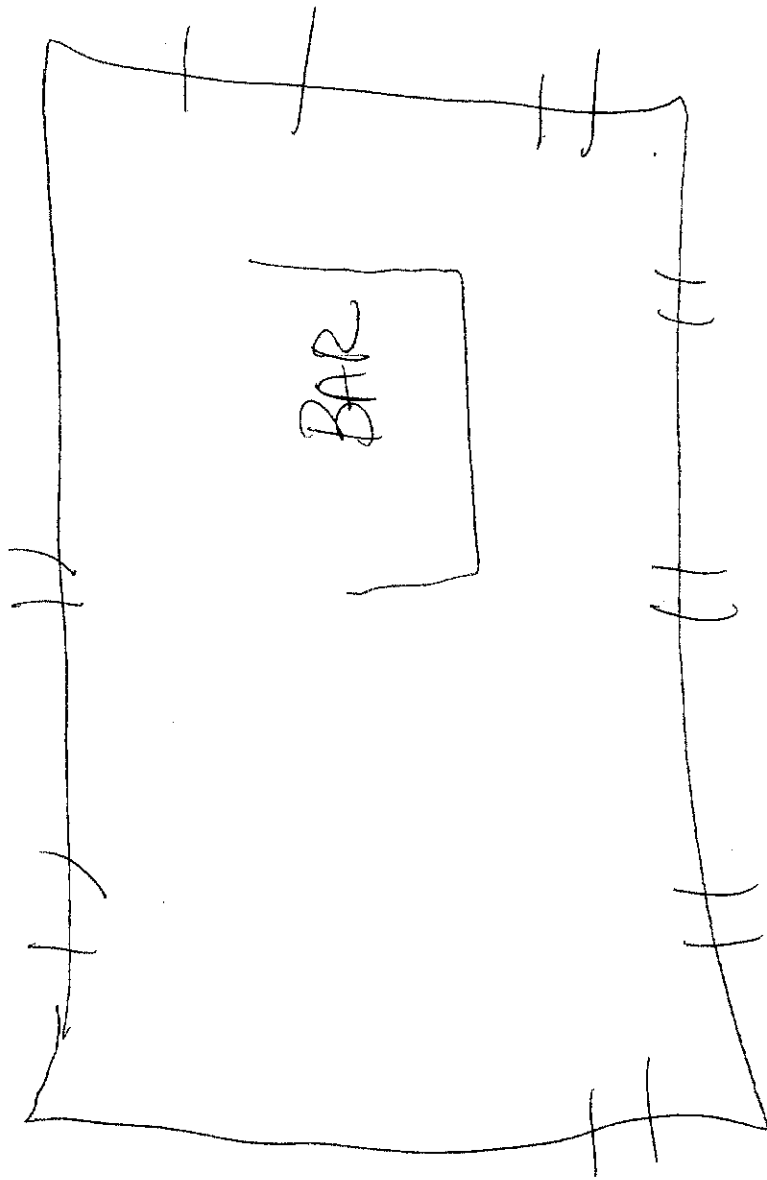
