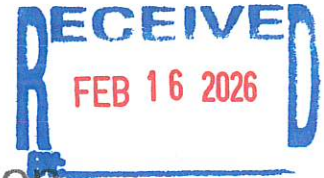

You Honor, people of the committee,

Daisy dog does not attack people or show any kind of aggression towards anyone. To people she is shy and timid, the issue is other dogs that are aggressive toward her. Unfortunately she is 90 pounds and can hold her own. Please don't take her size and your fear on her fate. I can prove without a reasonable doubt she's not aggressive. People are safe around her, it's just some dogs that are aggressive provoke her.

In both occasions she was on her own property. In either case it has yet to be proven beyond a reasonable doubt that she did bite a human. In the first case no citation, nothing to fight against. I met with Ms. Skully and making payments to her and we are good.

This new accusation. I have not gotten any proof at all. My son heard a guy hollering outside so he ran out the house, I followed in stocking feet and saw a guy holding Daisy by her collar and she was sitting on her back haunches and he was reaching in his pocket for a knife threatening to stab my son, dog, then me. He wouldn't let go of Daisy until I threatened to hit him and he realized he had one hand in his pocket and one holding my dog, so he let go of Daisy. We got Daisy in the house so I went out to talk to him and he was on 911 and he was yelling holding a pocket knife swinging it at me, I was backing up as he came towards me hollering that I was after him. I got in the house and shut the door. He continued hollering and swinging his knife, no dogs anywhere, his dogs were gone.

I have seen no pictures or statements or anything, just the cops come over in the middle of the night and demand I pull Daisy out of my son's bed and bring her to the Humane Society.


To sum it all up. Daisy is not aggressive. She will not attack people under any situation and is non aggressive. She was provoked on her property. She was not running around loose. She was in her yard. I have family, friends, and neighbors who will testify she is not dangerous.

On Monday morning at 9:49 am the humane society called and left a message that I was free to pick Daisy up and quarantine her at my home. An officer came to talk to me and I was unable to come to the door so I went downtown to pick up the report and talk to Humane Officer Mallory Meves. At that point she saw me and deemed my dog dangerous.

I am appealing the decision. I have witnesses to the incident and I am calling the police.

173.21 Holding animals for cause.

- (1) **GROUNDS.** A political subdivision may withhold, or direct a person contracting under s. 173.15 (1) to withhold, an animal in custody from an owner who makes an otherwise adequate claim for the animal under s. 173.23 (1) on any of the following grounds:
- (a) There are reasonable grounds to believe that the owner has used the animal in a crime under s. 944.18 or ch. 951 or that the animal constitutes evidence of a crime under s. 944.18 or ch. 951.
 - (b) There are reasonable grounds to believe that the animal poses a significant threat to public health, safety or welfare.

174.02 Owner's liability for damage caused by dog; penalties; court order to kill a dog.

(1) **LIABILITY FOR INJURY.**

- (a) *Without notice.* Subject to s. 895.045 and except as provided in s. 895.57 (4), the owner of a dog is liable for the full amount of damages caused by the dog injuring or causing injury to a person, domestic animal or property.
- (b) *After notice.* Subject to s. 895.045 and except as provided in s. 895.57 (4), the owner of a dog is liable for 2 times the full amount of damages caused by the dog biting a person with sufficient force to break the skin and cause permanent physical scarring or disfigurement if the owner was notified or knew that the dog had previously, without provocation, bitten a person with sufficient force to break the skin and cause permanent physical scarring or disfigurement.

(2) **PENALTIES IMPOSED ON OWNER OF DOG CAUSING DAMAGE.**

- (a) *Without notice.* The owner of a dog shall forfeit not less than \$50 nor more than \$2,500 if the dog injures or causes injury to a person, domestic animal, property, deer, game birds or the nests or eggs of game birds.
- (b) *After notice.* The owner of a dog shall forfeit not less than \$200 nor more than \$5,000 if the dog injures or causes injury to a person, domestic animal, property, deer, game birds or the nests or eggs of game birds, and if the owner was notified or knew that the dog previously injured or caused injury to a person, domestic animal, property, deer, game birds or the nests or eggs of game birds.

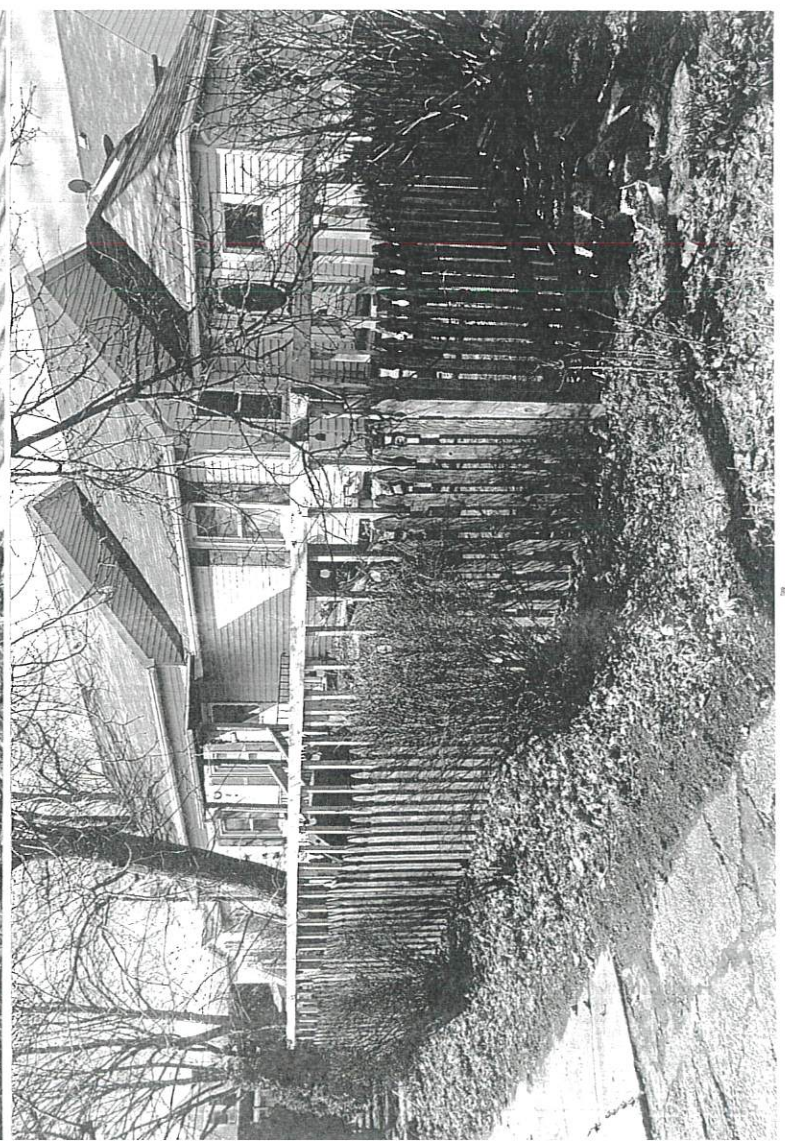

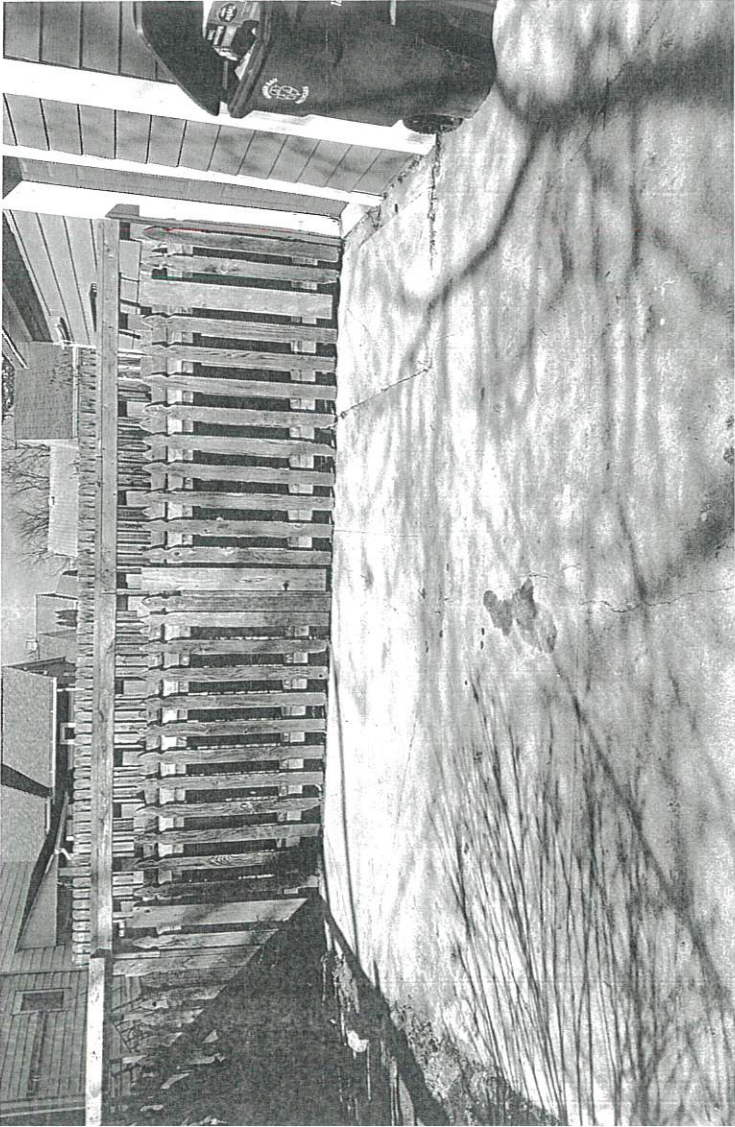

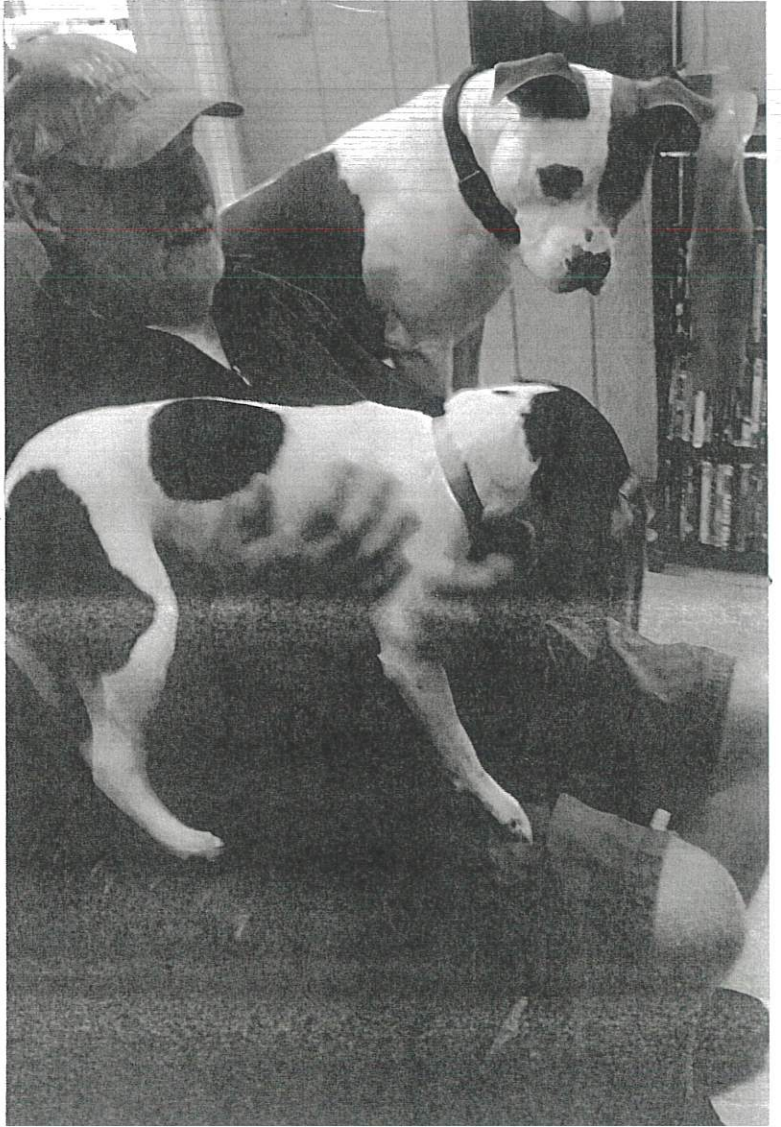

On February 9, 2026, at 8:38 a.m., I (716H) Sworn Humane Officer M. Meves, was contacted by the WI Humane Society inquiring if the Pitbull dog, Daisy on bite quarantine from an exposure on February 5, 2026, could be released back to its owner; Carl F. Kurowski, M/W, to satisfy the remainder of the quarantine at the owners site as they were able to supply a current rabies vaccine. I granted the reclaim and home quarantine only if Carl could satisfy the remainder of the 3 veterinary wellness checks and obtain a '26 dog license. I notified the investigating Officer T. Buchmann and the Brown Co. Health Department of the updated information.

On February 9, 2026, at 9:49 a.m., the victim, William L. Fletcher, M/W, advised he and his dog were bit while walking on a public right of way by an un-controlled dog on 2/5/26 at 6:50 p.m. causing injury. William requested an officer standby to keep the peace so he could inquire renters/home insurance for the incident and to verify the at-fault dog's rabies certificate with the owner. William said the investigating officer mentioned the dog had a prior history of attacking other dogs and people and requested I look into the dangerous dog concerns on the premises. Looking up prior call history I saw that the at-fault dog, Daisy was involved in an attack on May 17, 2025, where she was un-controlled and attacked and bit a passerby and their leashed dog being walked resulting in injury, ref. 25-223128. There was also no 2026 dog license for the animal which is required January 1st of any calendar year per city ord. 6-2(a)/WI ss174.07. Given the bite history while un-controlled and on a public right of way Daisy met criteria of the City of Green Bay's Dangerous Dog ordinance 6-13. I completed a written dangerous dog declaration order requiring the dog to be removed from the Green Bay City limits or be surrendered by February 16, 2026 upon satisfying the bite quarantine requirements per WI ss95.21, city ord. 6-12. Please refer to the attached documents. I also generated additional citations for No Dog License 6-2(a) and Penalty for Dog Causing Injury Damage 6-8(g) to be served to Carl.

On 2/9/26 at 10:45 a.m., Officer B. Prange and I attempted contact at Carl's residence at 1283 Crooks Street without success. A black pickup truck registered to Carl was parked in the driveway but there was no response at the front or side service doors. At 10:51 a.m., I attempted phone contact with Carl at [redacted] without success and a voicemail message was left. I supplied William my business card and WI ss174.02 verbiage on Owner Liability for Dogs Causing Injury/Damage, Holding a Dog for Cause ss 173.21, and the city ordinance 6-13 regarding Dangerous Dogs. William obtained veterinary medical treatment for his injured dog, Mercedes following the attack. I supplied him an AXON citizen link to upload photos and invoices as a result of the un-provoked dog attack. Please refer to my department issued AXON body worn camera documenting the contacts. I completed a property referral for the animal violations on the premises.

WI Humane Society staff said Carl did not supply confirmation of the remaining veterinary wellness checks to ensure the quarantine would be met and encouraged he contact myself. Per Officer Buchmann's details Carl was not cooperative with the investigation as he failed to supply the rabies vaccination certificate, was hesitant to turn over the dog for quarantine and refused to sign the Rabies Control Order form or accept the citation and locked the door without response. Given Carl's lack of cooperation I have requested Daisy remain at the isolation for quarantine due to the public health and safety concern.

On February 9, 2026 at 12:45 p.m., Carl showed up at the Green Bay Police Department lobby and met with myself and cover Officer E. Elbe. Carl was served the dangerous dog declaration order, 2 additional citations for No Dog License, and Penalty for Dog Causing Injury/Damage. I supplied him a copy of ord. 6-13 and explained the appeals process. I advised the dog Daisy would need to be removed from the city limits or surrendered by February 16, 2026. I offered if he surrendered the dog I would withdraw the 2 additional citations. Daisy would need to remain at the WI Humane Society (isolation facility) for quarantine due to public health and safety concerns and his prior lack of cooperation. I inquired if he had home owners insurance coverage and he mentioned he had McMillan but couldn't recall the spelling, contact information, policy, etc. I requested he follow up regarding the victim's request for a claim. Carl denied the insurance company knew of Daisy's bite/attack history. Carl said there wasn't blood everywhere and dismissed the severity of the incident. Carl appeared disgruntled, accepted the supplied documents and left without further contact. There is no further information at this time.

I offered him the option to still supply an alternative address or have the dog boarded at his expense outside the city limits to avoid being held at WHS. Carl indicated he understood. Attorney Cochart confirmed the Clerk's office confirmed receipt of the filed appeal. Carl said he was given a hearing date on 2/23/26 at 4:00 p.m.

On Thursday, 02/05/2026, at approximately 19:14 hours, GBPD Dispatch received a report of a dog attack and bite to both another dog and a human at the corner of Crooks and Irwin. GBPD Dispatch sent me to victim's home at 115 S. Irwin St. to investigate the incident.

Upon arrival, I met with the victim, identified as William L. Fletcher DOB: [REDACTED]. Fletcher told me that he was walking his dogs on leashes on the sidewalk at the intersection of Crooks and Irwin when a white Pitbull jumped the fence at 1283 Crooks St. and attacked his Black Lab/German Shepherd mix named Mercedes. He said that the Pitbull bit Mercedes on the neck, opening up a golf ball sized gash. Fletcher said he went to pry the Pitbull off his dog, and in the process, the Pitbull bit his ring and pinky fingers on his left hand, breaking the skin. Fletcher said the homeowners at 1283 Crooks St. came out and retrieved their Pitbull and brought it inside the house.

I photographed the very minor cuts on Fletcher's left hand. I also photographed the wound on Mercedes' neck. Fletcher said he spoke to a vet who will look at the wound in the morning. Fletcher did not have Mercedes' rabies vaccine information readily available, but I sent him an Axon link and told him to upload the rabies vaccine information and the vet bills after he visits the vet tomorrow morning.

I went to 1283 Crooks St. I looked up previous calls at this residence and discovered that Carl F. Kurowski DOB: [REDACTED] lived here and had a white Pitbull named Daisy that jumped the fence and attacked another dog in May of 2025. I called Carl before approaching the house and he was expecting the police to arrive. Carl came outside to talk to me.

Carl told me that he did not know how Daisy got out of his fenced in yard, but it could have been that his son, later identified as [REDACTED] DOB: [REDACTED], was coming inside the house with several items in his hands and may not have closed the gate all the way. I asked Carl if Daisy was up to date on her rabies vaccine. Carl told me Daisy got her vaccine shot the last time she attacked in May of 2025. Carl said he did not know where the paperwork was to prove the vaccination. I told him that Daisy would have to be quarantined at the Humane Society since he can not prove her vaccination records. Since he was intoxicated, I told him he could not drive to the Humane Society himself. Instead, I told him to get into my squad car and I would drive him and Daisy to the Humane Society, drop off the dog and I would return him home. Carl refused to get Daisy and come with me or turn the dog over. Carl became verbally defiant. I informed Carl that he was impeding our investigation and official police duties and that if he did not produce the dog, I would cite or arrest him for obstructing an officer. After a couple of minutes, [REDACTED] came outside with Daisy on a leash. [REDACTED] agreed to ride with the dog to the Humane Society, secure it inside a cage and I would give him a ride back. We completed this task with no issues. While at the Humane Society, I did photograph a rabies control tag that Daisy was wearing (2025 Rabies Vacc from Humane Society #47050), but without the accompanying paperwork, I cannot confirm that that tag belongs on Daisy.

Once I returned [REDACTED] home, Carl met us on the porch. I told Carl to wait one moment while I print out the Rabies Control Order for him to sign and I was also giving Carl a citation for Animal Unattended Within 5 Feet of Right of Way. Carl huffed when I told him that and went inside the house and locked the door. Once the paperwork was printed out, I called Carl's phone and knocked on the door. Carl would not answer the door or the phone. I left him a voicemail telling him that his citation is in the door and that I put down that he refused to come to the door to sign the Rabies Control Order, especially considering his defiant nature earlier, I doubt he would have agreed to sign it anyway.

This ended my involvement in this incident at this time.
