To whom it may concern:

My name is Lyn Kasper, my husband Jake Kasper, and I have had the pleasure of caring for Daisy for several days.

I would like to share with you the behavior I have personally witnessed from her.

1. Daisy is a very loving animal; she listens well in the house and when she is outside on her leash. I took her for several walks and even though she could overpower me she has not tried and listens to my directions. I was able to have her stop sit and wait, was able to redirect her easily if she got a smell of something new or interesting.
2. I tested her for food aggression, I was able to place my hand right in her food dish with no negative reaction, instead she very gently ate from my hand.
3. I have three labs – one is 12, one is 8, and one is a little over a year old. Please keep in mind that my two older labs are typically not fond of other dogs. My lab Harper that is only a little over year, still has not learned the meaning of personal space with people or other animals. Daisy and Harper get along and will play for hours at a time. Daisy will allow Harper to nibble and invade her personal space with no negative reactions. My 12-year-old Maggie did show her teeth and growl at Daisy and Daisy did not react aggressively back.

I have not seen any aggressive behavior from Daisy since she arrived at our home. She is not a dangerous dog and deserves another chance to be happy in her home with Carl and his son. I have not witnessed anything to justify her as being labeled highly aggressive as officer Meves stated to my husband Jake. When we took her in, we were prepared to handle a highly aggressive non obedient dog as this is how she described to Jake prior to her arrival from officer Meeves. The description given to us was not at all accurate. Daisy has been well behaved and a gentle girl even though she was in new surroundings with new humans, and other pets. Please feel free to contact myself or Jake if you have further questions or concerns.

From February 19, 2026, to March 5, 2026, there has been eight liquor law violations, two DA referrals, 14 citations issued, no massage violations, and one property referral.

On December 28, 2025, officers observed a disturbance happening outside 100 S Broadway, 100 Bar and Grill. Officers entered the bar and saw the air in the bar was contaminated by pepper spray. Due to no cooperation, bar owners were each cited for Disorderly House/Failure to Maintain Order and Maintaining a Chronic Nuisance.

On February 10, 2026, officers were dispatched to 1911 University Ave, Fiesta Latina, for the report of a physical disturbance. Three appearance warrants (citations) were issued for one male for Disorderly Conduct, Criminal Damage to Property, and Battery – Simple.

On February 12, 2026, officers observed a disturbance inside 100 S Broadway, 100 Bar and Grill. Two citations issued for one male for Obstructing an Officer – Misleading Case Investigation and Disorderly Conduct. One female issued citation for Disorderly Conduct. One bar owner issued citation for Maintaining a Chronic Nuisance 1st Offense and the other bar owner issued three citations for Violation of Stipulation/Agreement, Disorderly House/Failure to Maintain Order, and Maintaining a Chronic Nuisance 1st Offense.

On February 21, 2026, officers were dispatched to 613 Bodard St, Jill's Tavern, for a disturbance call. One male was arrested with charges referred to the DA for Disorderly Conduct and Obstructing or Resisting an Officer.

On February 25, 2026, officers completed a compliance check at BC's Bar and issued a warning for Violation of Stipulation/Agreement for not utilizing a functioning ID scanning device.

On February 25, 2026, officers completed a compliance check at 1238 State St, State Street Pub and issued owner a warning for Violation of Stipulation/Agreement for not utilizing a functioning ID scanning device and citation for No Licensed Operator on the Premises (Owner). Citation also issued to bartender for bartending without a license.

On February 28, 2026, officers were dispatched to 1139 Main St, Crown and Common, for a disturbance. One male was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct and another male was issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Lewd and Lascivious Behavior. No Trespass forms were completed.

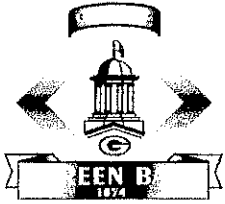


